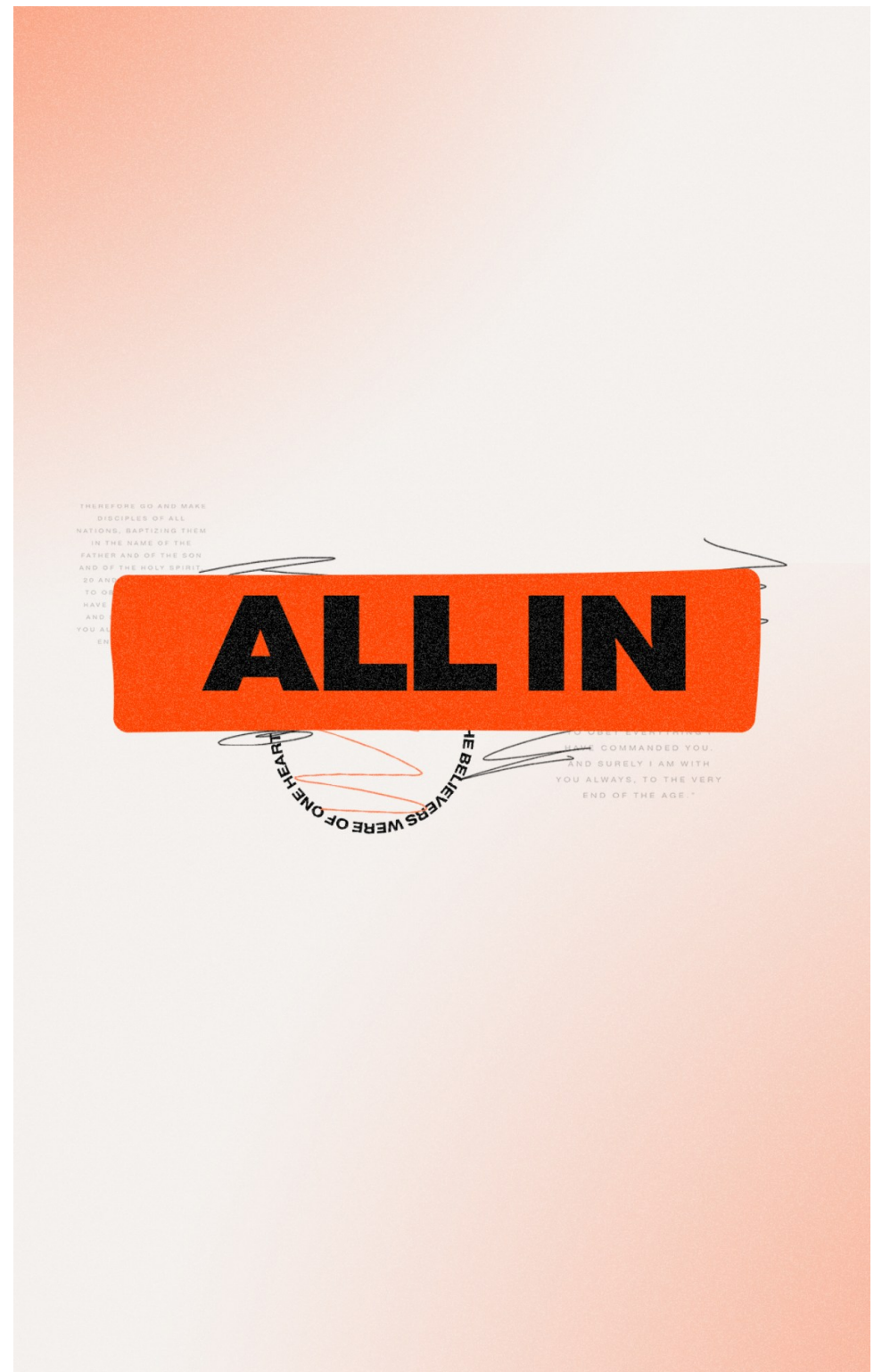

Notes

All the believers were united in heart and mind. And they felt that what they owned was not their own, so they shared everything they had. ³³The apostles testified powerfully to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and God’s great blessing was upon them all. ³⁴There were no needy people among them, because those who owned land or houses would sell them ³⁵and bring the money to the apostles to give to those in need. The Tension of Generosity

- We do not desire to be ungenerous
- We simply spend first and hope generosity survives
- If generosity depends on leftovers, it will almost always be occasional
- Money represents more than something we spend
- Giving feels threatening because it requires us to trust God
- The tension is not between giving and keeping
- The tension is between trusting God and trusting our possessions
- The tension will not be solved by waiting until giving feels easier
- The tension is solved by moving generosity from a leftover to a priority
