"Our Walk in Relationships"

Ephesians-Our Walk with Christ

Ephesians 6:21-24 (ESV)

²¹So that you also may know how I am and what I am doing, Tychicus the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord will tell you everything. ²²I have sent him to you for this very purpose, that you may know how we are, and that he may encourage your hearts. ²³Peace be to the brothers, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. ²⁴Grace be with all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with love incorruptible.

Sermon Summary:

Everyone desires to live a life of meaning. And there is no greater way to live with true purpose than through a deep, abiding relationship with Jesus. The Apostle Paul's letter to the Ephesians reveals the key to experiencing this kind of life. In **Part I** of this series, we'll explore the spiritual wealth we have as followers of Jesus—including the abundant blessings and divine wisdom available to us. In **Part II**, we'll deepen our understanding of our spiritual position as believers and the responsibilities that come with it—how we are called to live out our faith in light of what Christ has done.

- 10. How does Paul describe the love believers are to have for Christ?

Application Questions:

- 1. Who in your life could use encouragement right now, and how might you reach out this week?
- 2. What qualities do you think others would use to describe you as a servant of Christ?
- 3. How might God want to use you as an encourager in your family, church, or workplace?
- 4. Where do you most need Christ's peace in your life right now?
- 5. How do you see love and faith working together in your daily walk with Christ?
- 6. In what ways have you experienced God's grace recently, and how can you extend that grace to others?
- 7. What practices help you keep your love for Christ fresh and genuine?
- 8. How can you be more intentional about the words you leave with people in conversations, texts, or letters?
