Following Jesus: More Than A Checklist

“Connect”

8.16.26

Luke 5:17-26

¹⁷ One day while Jesus was teaching, some Pharisees and teachers of religious law were sitting nearby. (It seemed that these men showed up from every village in all Galilee and Judea, as well as from Jerusalem.) And the Lord's healing power was strongly with Jesus. ¹⁸ Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a sleeping mat. They tried to take him inside to Jesus, ¹⁹ but they couldn't reach him because of the crowd. So they went up to the roof and took off some tiles. Then they lowered the sick man on his mat down into the crowd, right in front of Jesus. ²⁰ Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the man, "Young man, your sins are forgiven." ²¹ But the Pharisees and teachers of religious law said to themselves, "Who does he think he is? That's blasphemy! Only God can forgive sins!" Luke 5:17-21

Checkpoints

- Connect - Choosing authentic community over isolated faith

The Catalyst of Connect

- Through connection, the paralytic experienced Jesus
 - Sometimes you need somebody else's faith to carry you until yours can stand on your own
- Through connection, the friends experienced Jesus
 - The greatest experiences with Jesus often come when you stop watching His work and start participating in it
- Through connection, the people experienced Jesus
 - Connection may begin with one relationship, but its impact can reach an entire community.
