## Worship Matters

3.8.26

“A Heart Poured Out”

James 4:36-50

One of the Pharisees asked Jesus to have dinner with him, so Jesus went to his home and sat down to eat.<sup>37</sup> When a certain immoral woman from that city heard he was eating there, she brought a beautiful alabaster jar filled with expensive perfume.<sup>38</sup> Then she knelt behind him at his feet, weeping. Her tears fell on his feet, and she wiped them off with her hair. Then she kept kissing his feet and putting perfume on them.<sup>39</sup> When the Pharisee who had invited him saw this, he said to himself, “If this man were a prophet, he would know what kind of woman is touching him. She’s a sinner!”<sup>40</sup> Then Jesus answered his thoughts. “Simon,” he said to the Pharisee, “I have something to say to you.”
