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CITY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Organized: A growing church has to build structure to bring in the harvest. Think about your own life right now — where do you sense God growing something (a relationship, a ministry, a habit of faith) but you haven't yet built the structure to sustain it? What would one small piece of "structure" look like this week?
2. Gifted: Every one of us was handed something to do. Take a few quiet minutes and actually name it — what is the specific gift, skill, time, or resource God has given you? Don't move to the next question until you've written it down in one sentence.
3. Ready: When the harvest comes in, the enemy comes with it. Recall the last time God was clearly at work in your life or family. What opposition showed up alongside it — discouragement, conflict, distraction, doubt? How did you respond, and how do you want to respond differently next time?
4. Of the three — organized, gifted, ready — which one exposes the area you personally need to grow in most right now? Be honest with yourself. What's making that area hard?
5. Look again at this week's three practices: name your gift, adopt one of the fifty, take one job off a tired leader. Commit to one specific action tied to one of these before next Sunday. Write down what it is and when you'll do it.
