SUNDAY

01

Pray for each of you to grow in your knowledge and love for God, and love and cherish each other.

***Ephesians 1:15-23***

MONDAY

02

Pray that God would increase your love for His Holy Word and read it together as a family. ***Psalms 119:10-11***

TUESDAY

03

Pray the Spirit would help you to forgive each other and love like Jesus does. ***Ephesians 4:32***

WEDNESDAY

04

Pray for reconciliation from past hurts (siblings, in-laws, spouses, etc). ***2 Corinthians 5:18-19***

THURSDAY

05

Pray for godly friendships that encourage and lift up; pray that God uses you as a godly friend to others.

***Romans 12:9-10***

FRIDAY

06

Pray for intentional and ongoing good relationships with neighbors. ***Matthew 5:16***

SATURDAY

07

Pray that you honor God with your finances and be good stewards of what He has given us. Pray against love of money. ***Hebrews 13:5***

SUNDAY

08

Pray for any struggles your family is facing right now, for humility as you trust and lean on His sustaining grace. ***James 4:6***

MONDAY

09

Pray as parents/grandparents/aunts-uncles about disciplining the children in your life; Children, ask God to help you honor those who teach you. ***2 Timothy 2:1-2***

TUESDAY

10

Pray about using the internet, pray for responsible use of it for adults, teens and children. ***Philippians 4:8-9***

WEDNESDAY

11

Pray about ways your family has fun together, and pray about ways you can serve your community together. ***Joshua 24:15b***

THURSDAY

12

Pray about any health issues in your family, trust God for His promise of an end to suffering when we are with Him forever. ***Revelation 21:4***

FRIDAY

13

Pray about any anxiety, depression, loneliness or fear any of you are experiencing. Bring it to Jesus. ***Psalms 56:3-4***

SATURDAY

14

Pray for anyone in your family who doesn't know Jesus as their Savior and King, pray they see purity and reverence in you, and that God would prepare their hearts to seek Him. ***Matthew 5:16***

SUNDAY

15

Pray for the Spirit to equip you for whatever work God has you doing or is calling you to do now. ***Ephesians 2:10***

MONDAY

16

Pray for your activities, whether school, work, ministry or social that they would be honoring to God. ***Colossians 3:17***

TUESDAY

17

Pray for protection against evil influences, temptations and attacks of the enemy. Ask the Lord to guard your hearts and minds. ***John 17:15-16***

WEDNESDAY

18

Pray for guidance and godly wisdom, pray for an enduring and persevering faith to run the race He has set before us. ***Hebrews 12:1-3***

THURSDAY

19

Pray for unity and ask the Lord to preserve the bond you have as a family. ***Proverbs 17:17***

FRIDAY

20

Pray for protection of your home, that it be a place of blessing, love and hospitality. ***Luke 6:30-35***

SATURDAY

21

Pray for your extended family members and ask God to show you how to be instruments of blessing to them. **2 Timothy 2:14-15**

SUNDAY

22

Pray that God would be the center of your relationships and show you how to love each other as Christ loves us. **Matthew 22:34-39**

MONDAY

23

Pray against any anger, strife, or bitterness. Ask for forgiveness where needed and for changed hearts. **James 5:16**

TUESDAY

24

Pray for your marriage, that by the power of the Spirit you love one another with the love of God even when it's challenging **1 Corinthians 13:7**. Children, pray for your Dad and Mom.

WEDNESDAY

25

Pray for peace to rule abundantly in your home, that God's peace that passes all understanding is in your heart. **Philippians 4:4-9**

THURSDAY

26

Pray for the Spirit to continue to sanctify each of you, transforming you into the likeness of Jesus, obedient to the Father. **Philippians 2:12-13**

FRIDAY

27

Pray against envy, toxic comparison and coveting and instead ask the Lord to be content and trusting in His sufficiency. **Psalms 23:1**

SATURDAY

28

Pray for healing from harsh words and bad intentions by filling you with His love so you can forgive and let go of hurts. **Ephesians 4:32**

SUNDAY

29

Pray for the joy of the Lord to be in your hearts always, in all circumstances, and even in difficult or challenging times. **Romans 15:13** May His Word be a lamp to your feet and a light to your path. **Psalms 119:105**

MONDAY

30

Young adults and teens, pray **1 Timothy 4:12**, that you will be an example in your speech, conduct, love, faith and purity.
