Frequently Asked Questions

General

- 1. Why Denver and Tijuana?
 - As a church, we believe that an effective cross cultural ministry trip requires a healthy partnership in the field. Because of this, we have prayed for each location and believe that these are the ministries that God is asking us to partner with and serve.
- 2. How are the costs of the trips calculated?
 - Trips are calculated based on food, ministry opportunities, travel, and lodging costs. Budgets will be
 reviewed with the whole team in detail during team training. We try to keep the cost of each trip as low as
 possible.
- 3. How do I know if I should attend one or both of the trips?
 - Take time to pray and ask God if you should attend both trips. Part of that process will include checking your schedule, talking to trusted mentors/parents, and considering the financial ramifications of each trip.

Finances

- 1. What if I don't raise enough money or I don't get it in on time?
 - All participants are held accountable for paying the agreed upon price of either trip. If monetary deadlines
 are missed, the MS and HS pastors will set up a meeting with individuals who have missed the deadline(s) to
 determine if trip attendance is wise.
- 2. Do I need to send Prayer letters if I can pay for the trip myself?
 - Yes. The purpose of prayer letters is to primarily raise prayer support and then to allow people to partner with the ministry financially.
- 3. What do I do with extra money that I raise?
 - Anyone who gives to the trip does so with the understanding that their money is given to GHCC to be used as God directs. If any extra money remains after the trip it stays under the authority of GHCC.
- 4. If I have raised support and then I am no longer able to attend the trip what happens to the money?
 - A letter must be sent out to all supporters letting them know of your absence. Because support is for the trip no refunds will be given to individual donors.

Attendance

- 1. How many times can I miss meetings?
 - Any unexcused absence is grounds for disqualification from the team.
- 2. How do I communicate absences?
 - · All absences must be communicated to MS and HS Pastor by your scheduled interview
- 3. If I initially sign up for one trip and after the teams have been formed I want to go on the other, can I do so?
 - If space is still available, then yes.

Application Process

- 1. What happens if I turn my application in late?
 - Late applications will not be accepted.
- 2. Do I have to have all the reference forms filled out?
 - Yes, all references are required. Students are required to have three references, leaders only need two.
- 3. What if my schedule doesn't allow for an interview during the allotted time period?
 - A special interview must be set up with the MS or HS pastor no later than March 26th at 5pm.
