**II. WE ARE GOD'S PEOPLE AND RECIPIENTS OF MERCY
(1 PETER 2:10)**

A. Being a Christian includes a radical transformation: from not being to being

1. Not counted among God's people and not a recipient of mercy (**Ephesians 2:1-3, 11-12**)

2. Now counted among God's people and a recipient of mercy (**Ephesians 2:4-9, 13-22**)

B. Peter's allusion of the gospel in Hosea (**1 Peter 2:10; Hosea 1:6-10; 2:20, 23**)

C. We are God's people and recipients of mercy because of God

1. God shows mercy to those who are saved (**Ephesians 2:4-5; Titus 3:4-5; 1 Peter 1:3-4**)

2. God has mercy on whomever He wills (**Romans 9:9-26**)

3. We are recipients of mercy to the praise of God's glory (**Romans 9:23; Ephesians 1:3-6**)
