

## **Journey Students Intern**

### **Classification**

This position is a Non-Exempt, Hourly position.

### **Hours/Rate:**

- 20 hours per week / \$15 per hour
- Housing or a lodging stipend is NOT provided with this position

### **Overview**

The Journey Students Internship is designed to equip the intern with leadership and learning opportunities through practical, hands-on ministry experience. Throughout the Summer, the intern will learn how to plan and execute student ministry services, events, volunteer meetings, and social media. The intern will also be asked to use both written and verbal communication in large and small groups of parents and adults.

### **Schedule (20+ hrs per week)**

Weekly hours will be arranged by the supervisor and intern based upon availability; hours may vary as needs arise within Student Ministry (i.e. special events, training, camps, etc.). Internship begins on or about mid May and ends on or about late July (about 10-12 weeks long). Weekly hours will generally look like:

- **Sunday:** 7am - 12pm
- **Monday:** 10am - 2pm
- **Tuesday:** 10am - 3pm (all staff meeting)
- **Wednesday:** 3pm - 9pm (Midweek Program)

### **Job Responsibilities**

The following tasks will be accomplished with the help of the Journey Students Director. As this list is not exhaustive, the intern should maintain an overall attitude of willingness to jump in as needed. These responsibilities can also be tailored to fit the candidate or ministry needs depending on strengths and weaknesses.

- **Assist Journey Students Director**
  - Learn various ins and outs of successfully leading a student ministry
  - Contribute ideas and perspectives that are consistent with the overall vision and mission of Journey and Journey Students

- **Student Large Groups**
  - Help plan Large Group and Pre-Service environments
  - Host Middle and High School large group environments as needed
  - Prepare and deliver messages
  - Assist in scheduling large group communicators
- **Student Small Groups**
  - Help plan meaningful small group moments
  - Facilitate Small Group Leader huddles
  - Help create, write, and distribute small group questions
  - Fill in as a Small Group leader as needed
- **Student Ministry Events**
  - Help plan, communicate, and execute events such as:
    - Middle School Test Drive
    - Senior Send-off
    - Promotion Sunday
    - Middle and High School Camp
    - End of Summer Party
    - Student Takeover

- Perform all duties and conduct your personal life according to Journey's teachings, practices, theological beliefs, and standards
- Pray for and with Journey Students team members, volunteers, and students
- Continually develop and demonstrate an authentic personal faith

- Communication coaching for a Student Ministry environment
