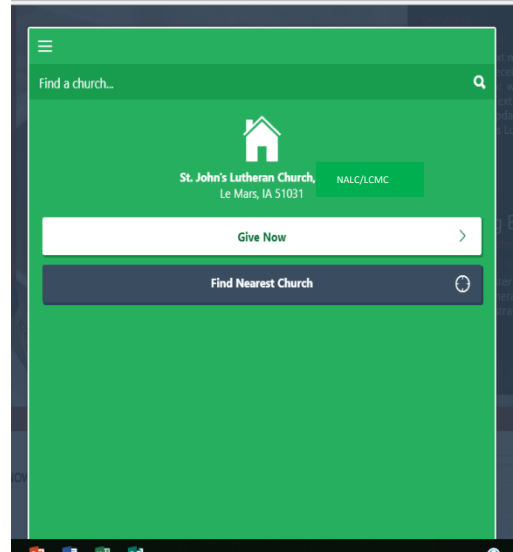
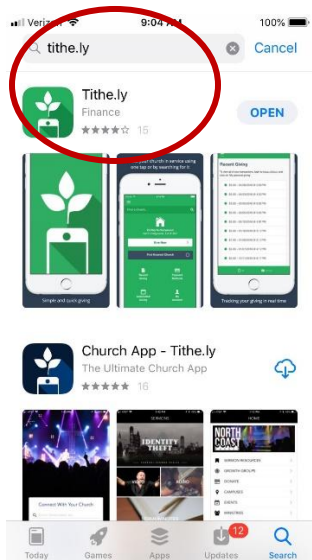


TITHE.LY APP

St. John's offers a **MOBILE APP** from Tithe.ly

You simply go to the App store on your phone and search for Tithe.ly. You will see numerous Tithe.ly apps - be sure to download **Tithe.ly Finance (the app will be green)**.



When you open the app, you will need to set up an account. Once you have your account set up, you will be ready to make a donation anytime, any place by searching for St. John's Lutheran Church; then following the instructions in the app.

We hope this will be a convenient and secure way for you to remember St. John's and to help the church meet its financial obligations throughout the summer months, when many of our parishioners are traveling.

ONLINE & MOBILE GIVING at St. John's

Please take a moment to think about these questions:

- How many people carry a cell phone to church?
- How many people carry a checkbook with them to church?
- How many people carry cash when attending church or other places?

According to Pew Research Center, over 70% of Americans own a smartphone. Of those 65 and older, 42% have a smartphone. Of those 50-64, 74% have a smartphone. You know we have our phones with us at church (and everywhere else we go). Since we are more likely to have our phones with us than checks or cash, it makes sense to offer a giving option that involves a mobile phone.

St. John's is ready to receive online donations and mobile giving through **Tithe.ly**. This will be another opportunity for members or visitors to help support St. John's ministries any day of the week.

With either method of donating, the church will incur processing & transaction fees. On the donation forms you will be given the choice to add the processing fees to your donation. The fees are also tax deductible.

Fees include: Credit/Debit	2.9% + \$.30 per transaction
ACH	1% + \$.30 per transaction
AMEX	3.5% + \$.30 per transaction
