

General Tour Conditions

NOTE: The cancellation fees stated below are basic and will apply to anyone who cancels. Additional Airlines Cancellation Charges may be incurred in accordance with the particular rules of the airline used. Most tickets are nonrefundable, but every effort is made to recover all funds possible.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Deluxe and First Class hotels throughout the tour. Price is based on TWO persons sharing a room. If you do not have a room-mate and Ed Hill Tours is unable to arrange one, you must pay a supplemental charge. Single rooms are subject to availability and some may be smaller than most twin or double rooms.

A full breakfast and dinner in Israel throughout the tour. Lunches are not provided unless indicated.

SIGHTSEEING:

Includes the service of an English speaking guide and all entrance fees to sites included in the program. Private motor coach or other conveyance included as indicated on your tour brochure.

LUGGAGE:

One suitcase will be handled for you upon arrival overseas (after you clear customs) and transferred between airports/piers and hotels, etc. You must have proper group identification on all checked pieces of luggage while on tour. Travel and cancellation insurance should be purchased to protect the passenger against loss.

TRANSFERS:

You will be transferred with the group between airports.

NOT INCLUDED:

Not included unless arranged by the tour host: 1) Airport taxes and departure taxes; 2) Passport fees and visas; 3) Immigration & customs fees; 4) Fuel surcharges as imposed by airlines or other suppliers; 5) Domestic transportation to/from your hometown to the group departure city; and 6) port charges, as applicable. RESPONSIBILITY:

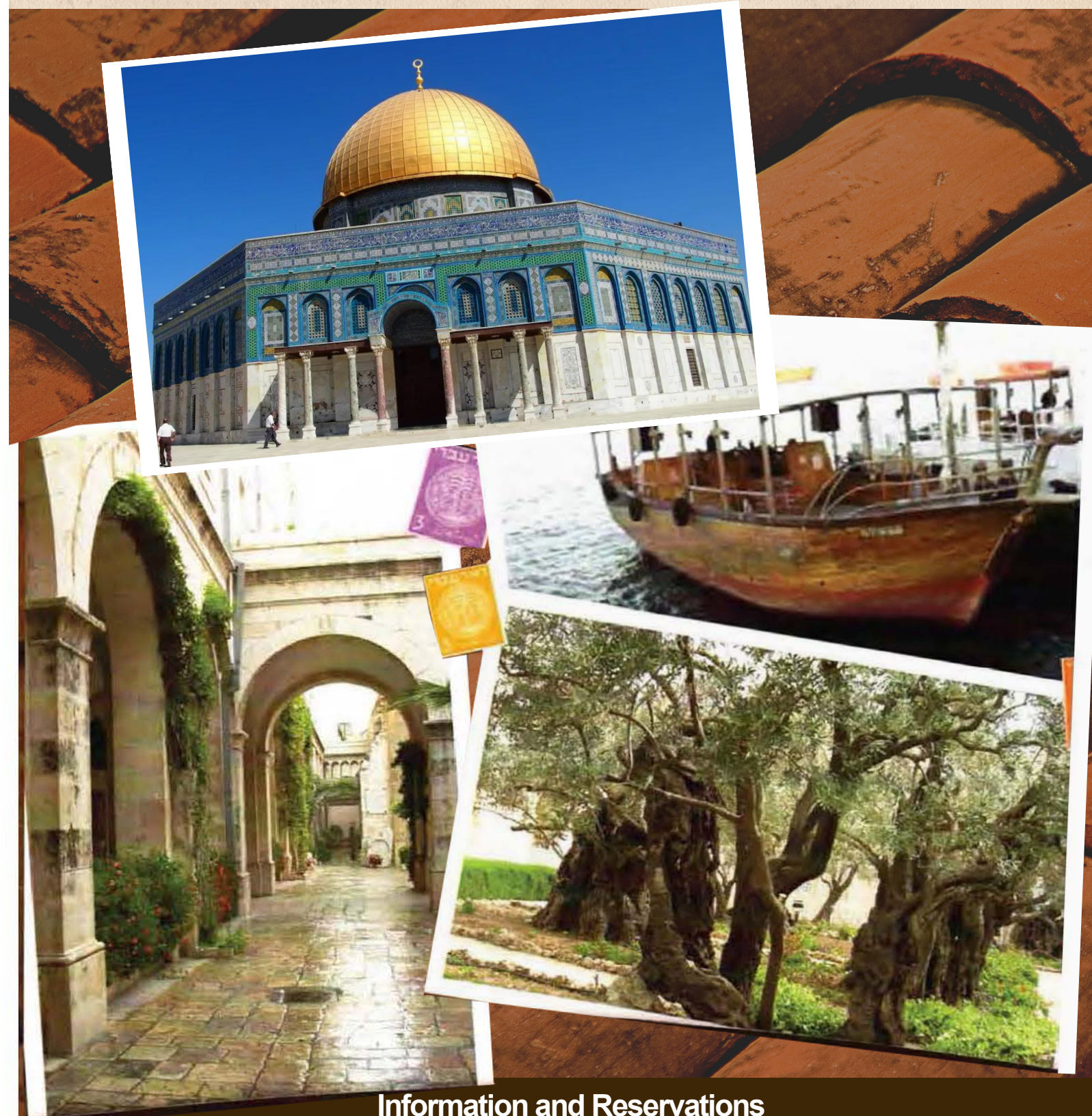

We re-enter the Old City to visit the Davidson Museum and the southern steps to the Temple Mount. We'll go to the Lithostratos, where we view the actual streets of Jerusalem Jesus would have walked, the remains of Pilate's Judgment Hall and the Ecce Homo Arch. We then walk the Via Dolorosa, passing through intriguing markets and bazaars and visit the church of the Holy Sepulchre, believed by many to be the place of Jesus' crucifixion and burial. We'll also visit the Garden Tomb which is considered the highlight of our tour! There we will worship and celebrate communion beside the empty tomb. "He is risen; He is not here!" What a wonderfully meaningful conclusion to this truly memorable day! Dinner and overnight.

PETRA

Petra was founded over 2000 years ago along the ancient routes between Arabia, Egypt, and the Mediterranean Sea. The capital city was bustling with life, full of lush gardens, ornate houses, and markets loaded with exotic goods from India, Arabia, and Egypt and was part of the route that Moses took on his Exodus journey. In 2007, Petra was voted one of the new seven wonders of the world!!

JERUSALEM

Among the many other sites we will visit in Jerusalem is the Mt. of Olives which has an outstanding view of the Old City walls and the Eastern (Golden) Gate. From there we descend by foot on the "Palm Sunday Road" to the Garden of Gethsemane for a service in the Garden with time to reflect in this lovely setting ... olive trees, perhaps 2000 years old still stand today. We travel around the Old City walls, viewing the tombs of Absalom and Zachariah and continue to the House of Caiphas where Jesus was held the night before His crucifixion... there we will stand on the same stone steps Jesus would have walked up Mt. Zion. We then visit The Upper room (Last Supper room) and have a brief service. Return to our hotel for dinner, free time and overnight.

We will motor through modern Jerusalem, viewing the Knesset, seat of the Israeli Parliament, then go to the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed and visit the amazing scale model of Jerusalem at the time of Christ. We proceed to Yad Vashem, the memorial to the six million Jews who perished during the Holocaust. After lunch, we walk through the Cardo, the bustling heart of ancient Jerusalem, then visit the Western (Wailing) Wall where we may write prayers on paper and place them in the niches of the wall. We proceed to the Western Wall (Rabbi's) Tunnel where we come to a place considered nearest the site of the Holy of Holies. We proceed to the Pool of Bethesda and the church of St. Anne, where we can sing in a church with a 10-second echo! We leave the Old City through the Lion's Gate. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.



CAESAREA/MT. CARMEL/ CANA/TIBERIAS

Our spiritual journey in the Holy Land will include traveling north along the Mediterranean Sea to visit Caesarea, the ancient seaport built by Herod the Great. Then we ascend to Mt. Carmel, the site of Elijah and the prophets of Baal. From here we have an astounding view of the Jezreel Valley/Valley of Armageddon. We'll proceed to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus then drive to Cana of Galilee where Jesus performed His first miracle. Then on to Tiberias where we have our first view of the beautiful Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight at our hotel located on the sea shore.

GALILEE BOAT RIDE/MT. OF BEATITUDES/JORDAN RIVER

View the sunrise over the tranquil Sea of Galilee. After breakfast, we take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee but not before pausing for a brief service. We'll visit Nof Ginossar to see the recently discovered ancient boat from the time of Jesus then proceed to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus spoke the Sermon on the Mount. There, we'll have a brief service overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Our day ends at the Jordan River for a touching baptismal service. Dinner and overnight at the our hotel.

GOLAN HEIGHTS/ CAESAREA PHILIPPI

This will be a day of adventure. We drive to the Golan Heights, a strategic yet beautiful plateau. We will travel to Caesarea Philippi/Banias, the site of Peter's confession: "Thou are the Christ." We'll stand at the head waters of the Jordan River, visit the ruins of ancient temples and have time for a walk by the stream and waterfall. We return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

BET SHEAN /QUMRAN/ DEAD SEA/MASADA

Today we travel through the Jordan Valley to Bet Shean, one of the ancient cities of the Decapolis dating from the 5th Century B.C. Today it is the site of the largest archaeological excavation in Israel. We will drive near Jericho, viewing the Mount of Temptation and Mount Nebo in Jordan from which Moses viewed the Promised Land. We visit Qumran, the discovery site of the Dead Sea Scrolls. After lunch, we travel along the Dead Sea to Masada and ascend by state-of-the-art cable cars to visit the mountaintop palace of Herod the Great and the famous fortress, where from A.D. 70-73, the Jewish defenders made their last stand against Rome. We will view the fascinating remains of Herod's palace, storehouses, cisterns, and ancient synagogue. We visit the Dead Sea - the lowest point on earth, where we can swim and enjoy the therapeutic properties of the water without the possibility of sinking. We then begin our ascent of nearly 4000 feet to Jerusalem. Our first view of the Holy City will be from Mt. Scopus where we will have time to reflect on our entry. Dinner and overnight at our beautiful hotel in the center of Jerusalem.



DEPART

We will depart for Orlando Int'l Airport where we will board our flight to Tel Aviv, Israel. Dinner and breakfast are served during the flight and we have time to rest.

TEL AVIV

We arrive in Israel at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel Aviv. After brief airport formalities and baggage claim, we meet our guide and are escorted to our waiting motor coach. We proceed directly to our hotel in Tel Aviv for check-in, dinner and overnight.
