## **Sermon Outline for “I AM” Part #8 “The Vine”**

<sup>13</sup>“For my people have done two evil things: They have abandoned me— the fountain of living water. And they have dug for themselves \_\_\_\_\_ cisterns that can hold no water at all! Jeremiah 2:13

<sup>13</sup>Jesus replied, “Anyone who drinks this water will soon become thirsty again. <sup>14</sup>But those who drink the water I give will \_\_\_\_\_ be thirsty again. It becomes a fresh, bubbling spring within them, giving them eternal life.” John 4:1-29

<sup>1</sup>“I am the \_\_\_\_\_ grapevine, and my Father is the gardener. <sup>2</sup>He cuts off every branch of mine that doesn’t produce fruit, and he prunes the branches that do bear fruit so they will produce even more. <sup>3</sup>You have already been pruned and purified by the message I have given you. <sup>4</sup>Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me. <sup>5</sup>“Yes, I am the vine; you are the \_\_\_\_\_ Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing. John 15:1-17
