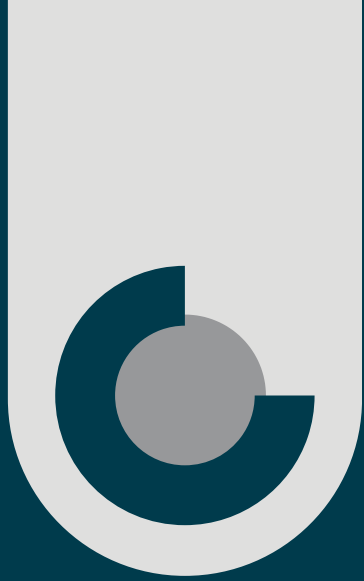


WELCOME MESSAGE

OUR STORY

1973

Windsor Road Christian Church began in May 1973 as a small gathering of believers meeting in a movie theater, then known as the Congregational Christian Church. Just a year later, the church took on the name Windsor Road Christian Church, and by 1976 moved into a 200-seat worship center on its current property—a clear sign of God’s early provision and growth.



1984

Over the next decade, the church steadily expanded, reaching around 280 people and completing an addition in 1984 that then served as the home for our children’s ministries. As momentum continued, a second worship service was added in 1987, reflecting a growing and vibrant congregation.

TODAY

A new addition was completed in 2015 including a Cafe and Indoor Playground, as well as a nursery, classrooms, and large group space for our Kids Ministry. Today, we welcome around 600 people each Sunday, including worshipers from every generation. Over the past decade, we have experienced meaningful growth in Kingdom Diversity, intentionally seeking to reflect the rich cultural mosaic of the Champaign-Urbana area.



OUR COMMUNITY



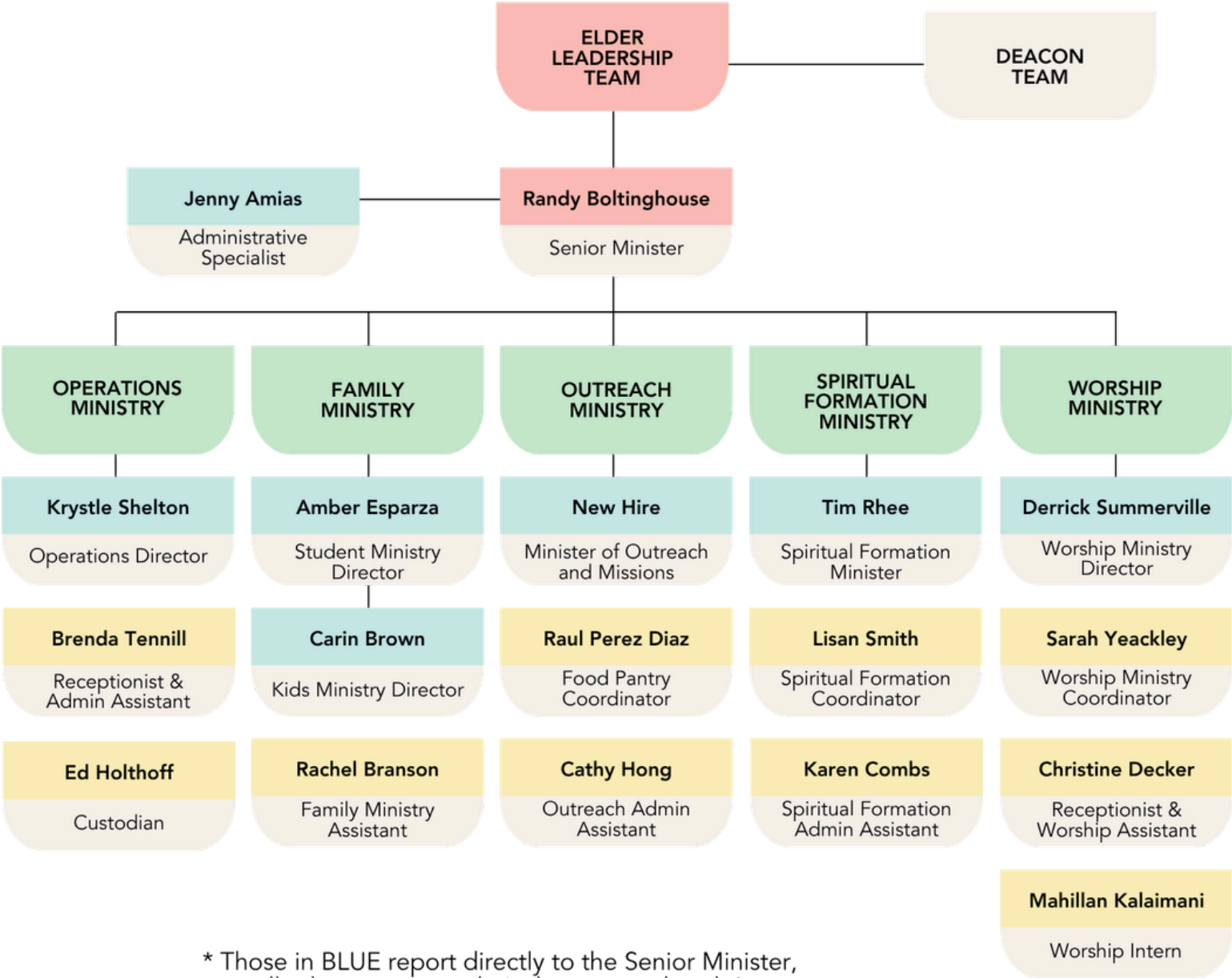
CHAMPAIGN-URBANA, ILLINOIS

HOW TO APPLY



WINDSORROAD.ORG/CAREERS

- Prayerfully review the job description
- Submit a cover letter
- Submit a resume with references (name & contact information)
- Submit 2 letters of recommendation
- Submit an autobiographical faith story (1-2 pages)
- Submit a link to a recording of teaching or preaching within the last 3 years

PROCESS:

Submissions will be reviewed as applications are received and until a successful candidate is selected. Selected applicants may be contacted for interviews and reference checks will be conducted. Prior to any offer, candidate must complete and pass a background check.

The interview process may include a site visit as well as meeting with the Hiring Committee, Elders, staff, volunteers, and community partners. Ideal start date is as soon as possible upon hire.
