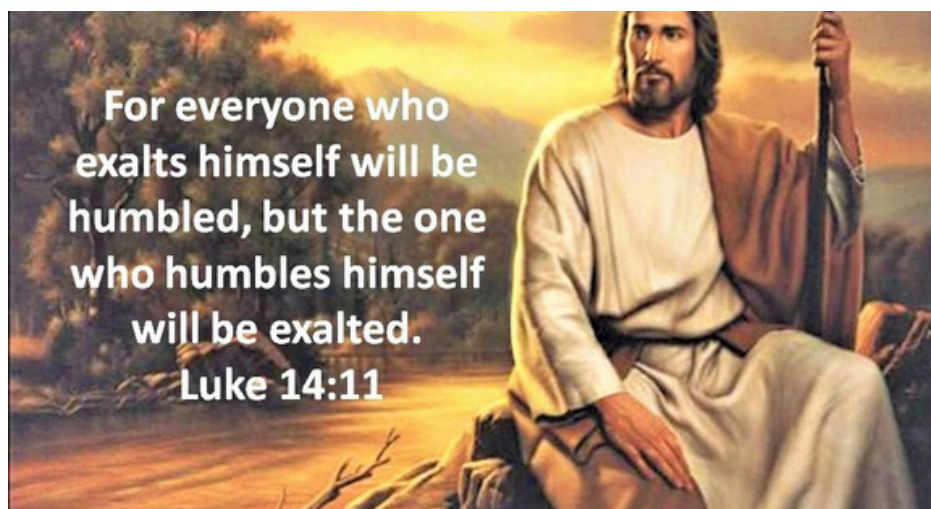

RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST, DO I ENTER?

In today's Gospel from Luke 14:1, 7-14, Jesus challenges us to live in humility and to recognize that greatness in God's eyes does not come from honor, wealth, or status, but from how we serve others. This is something we see echoed in popular culture, even in simple ways like Dhar Mann videos. Many of his stories start with someone who looks down on others—someone proud, arrogant, or selfish—and in the end, they are humbled, while those who were mistreated are lifted up. Jesus reminds us of this same truth: "For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." As members of the Polish National Catholic Church, we are called to live out this humility not just in our church pews, but also in our daily lives, treating our neighbors, co-workers, and even strangers with the dignity and respect that Christ shows to us.

This teaching touches deeply on our cultural values of *respeto* and *familia*. In our families and communities, we know that true honor comes not from titles or positions, but from sacrifice, hospitality, and caring for others. Humility and service are woven into our history—faith expressed through helping those in need, sharing meals, and welcoming all into the community. Jesus asks us to live not for applause or recognition, but for the joy of serving Him through others. Reflect on this: When was the last time I humbled myself so someone else could be lifted up? Do I seek recognition, or do I serve because I see Christ in my neighbor?
