JESUS HAS THERE ALL ALONG

On this Third Sunday of Easter, Year A, we encounter the risen Christ walking alongside the disciples on the road to Emmaus. At first, they do not recognize Him. Their hearts are heavy with confusion, disappointment, and grief. Yet Jesus draws near, listens to their story, and gently opens the Scriptures to them. In this moment, we are reminded that even when we feel lost or distant from God, Christ is already walking with us—patiently guiding us toward understanding and hope.

It is in the breaking of the bread that their eyes are finally opened. This powerful moment speaks deeply to our life in the Church, especially in the Eucharist. We too are invited to recognize Christ not only in Scripture, but in the sacramental life of the Church. As members of St. Jude the Apostle Polish National Catholic Church, we are called to be people whose hearts “burn within us,” transformed by the presence of the risen Lord. And like the disciples, once we recognize Him, we are sent forth with renewed faith to share the Good News with others.

Reflection Questions:

1. When have I experienced Christ walking with me in a moment of confusion or doubt?
2. How can I grow in recognizing Jesus more fully in the Eucharist and in my daily life?
