

In today's Gospel, Jesus shares the parable of the persistent widow who refuses to lose heart until justice is done. Through her perseverance, the Lord teaches us that prayer is not about convincing God, but about transforming our hearts to remain steadfast in faith. Like Moses raising his hands in prayer during Israel's battle against Amalek, we are reminded that persistence in prayer sustains us in the struggles of life. When we grow weary, the Church—through the community of believers—stands beside us, lifting us up just as Aaron and Hur supported Moses' arms.

St. Paul's words to Timothy echo the same message: "Proclaim the word; be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient." In a world often indifferent to faith, our perseverance in prayer and witness becomes an act of courage and love. God invites us to trust that even when answers seem delayed, His justice and mercy are always at work. The Church, guided by the Holy Spirit, continues to call us to hope — to remain faithful in prayer, in service, and in proclaiming the Gospel.

Reflection Questions:

- I. When have I been tempted to give up praying for something, and how might God be inviting me to persevere with renewed faith?
- 2. How can I, like Moses and the persistent widow, strengthen others in their faith through my prayer and example?
