STAY THE FAITH

As we approach the end of the liturgical year, the readings for this 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time remind us that everything in this world is passing. Jesus tells His disciples that even the most magnificent things—like the Temple in Jerusalem—will one day crumble. Yet, He also assures us that those who persevere in faith will gain their souls. In these words, we find both challenge and comfort: the challenge to remain steadfast in times of uncertainty, and the comfort of knowing that our hope rests not in earthly things, but in the eternal love and mercy of God.

Today, our parish family at St. Jude the Apostle Polish National Catholic Church celebrates a beautiful sign of that hope—the ordination of Fr. Robert Grizzell to the holy priesthood. The priesthood is not about status or recognition, but about service, sacrifice, and love. Like Christ, the priest is called to stand at the altar and in the world as a bridge between God and His people, proclaiming the Good News and offering his life for the sake of others. Fr. Robert's "yes" to God is a reminder that even in a world full of uncertainty, there are still hearts willing to say, "Here I am, Lord." 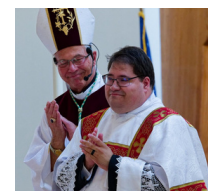
Bring a Friend to Church!
