## JESUS IS FIND US WHO ARE LOST

These parables speak personally to anyone who has felt disconnected, ashamed, or forgotten. They remind us that even when we feel unworthy, God’s love remains constant and searching. The invitation is simple yet profound: reflect on where you are in your journey, and know that Jesus is not waiting to punish, but to welcome. No matter how far you have wandered, no matter how long you’ve been away, your return brings joy to heaven. Let your heart be found, and let His love restore your soul.

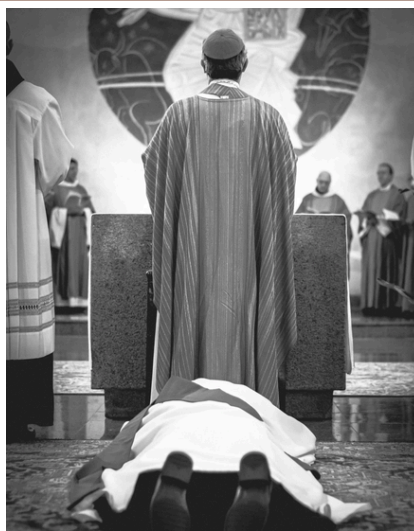
## GREETINGS FROM OUR PASTOR: REV. DR. MARCUS R. TINAJERO
