HOW ARE OUR HEARTS?

In this Fifth Sunday of Easter, we hear Jesus speak words meant to calm troubled hearts: “Do not let your hearts be troubled.” He reminds His disciples—and us—that He is the way, the truth, and the life. In a world filled with uncertainty, fear, and division, these words are not just comforting—they are a call to trust. Jesus does not promise an easy path, but He promises His presence. To follow Him is to walk in relationship, to trust even when we do not fully understand, and to believe that He is leading us to the Father.

The early Church in Acts shows us what living in that trust looks like. Faced with challenges and growing needs, the community comes together in unity and service. They appoint others to ensure no one is neglected, reminding us that faith is not only personal—it is lived out in care for one another. As the Body of Christ, we are called to build each other up, just as Saint Peter reminds us that we are “living stones,” built into a spiritual house. Each of us has a role in God’s plan, and each act of love strengthens the Church. As members of St. Jude the Apostle Polish National Catholic Church, we are invited to reflect on how we are living out this calling. Are we trusting Christ as the way in our daily lives? Are we building up our community through acts of service, compassion, and faith?

Reflection Questions:

1. In what areas of my life do I struggle to trust that Jesus is “the way, the truth, and the life”?
2. How can I actively serve others and help build up the Church as a “living stone”?
