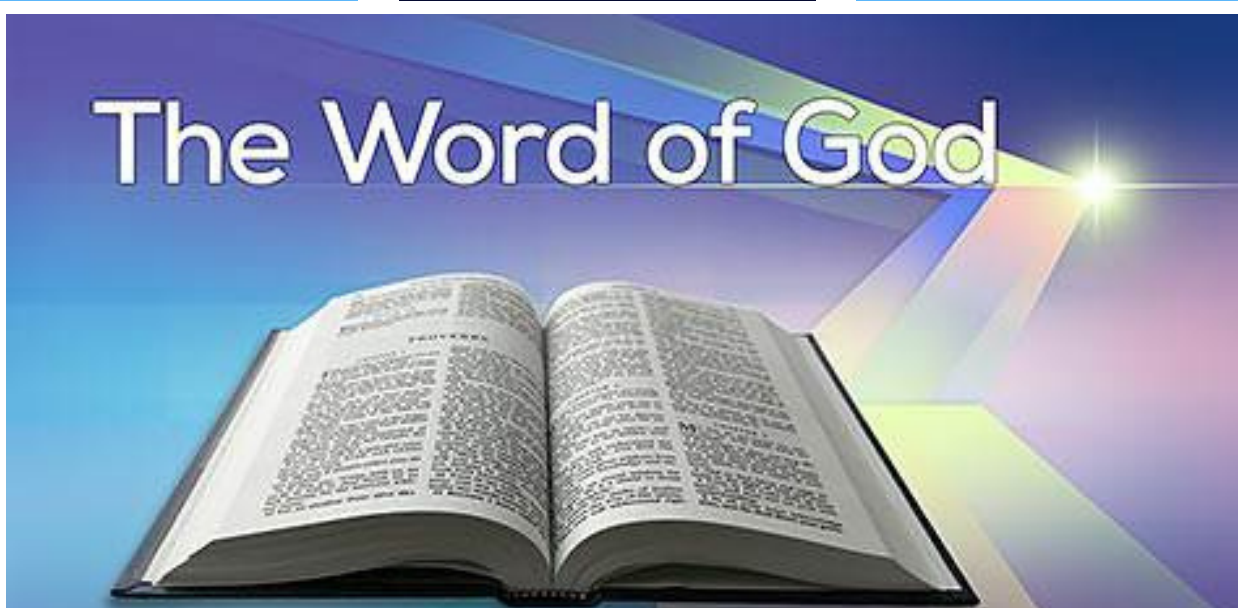

## WHAT IS THE SOLEMNITY OF THE WORD OF GOD

The Solemnity of the Word of God in the Polish National Catholic Church (PNCC) is a special day set aside to honor and celebrate the sacred Scriptures. This feast reminds everyone that the Bible is not just an old book, but a living message from God to all people. In the PNCC, the Word of God is central to worship, teaching, and daily life. The Church encourages people to listen to the readings at Mass with open hearts, and to let the words of Scripture guide their decisions, bring comfort in suffering, and give direction when life is confusing.

What makes the celebration of this day in the PNCC meaningful is its openness and warmth. The Church invites everyone—no matter where they are in their faith journey—to grow closer to God through the Bible. Unlike some churches that might focus only on tradition or doctrine, the PNCC emphasizes understanding, personal reflection, and the importance of reading Scripture in one's own language. This approach helps people feel welcomed and connected to God's message. On this day, there may be special blessings for Bibles, encouraging people to take them home and read them with their families.

The Solemnity of the Word of God is not just about listening to Scripture during church services. It's about building a relationship with God through His Word. The PNCC believes that the Bible speaks to everyone—young and old, married or single, hurting or hopeful. By reading the Word together as a community and in the quiet of our homes, we become closer to each other and to God. The Church hopes that this celebration will inspire more people to see the Bible as a gift and to live by its light every day.

Cleric Robert is a seminarian for the Polish National Catholic Church. He is currently in the process of preparing for his deacon and priestly ordinations.



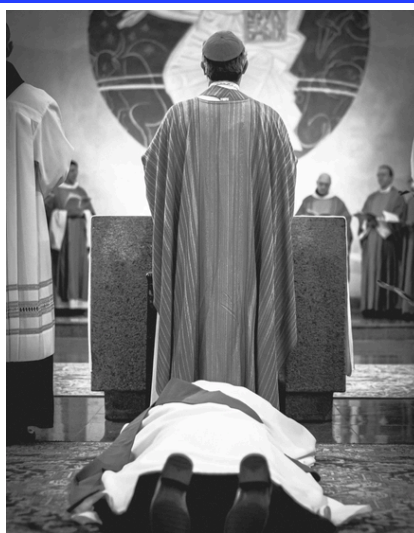
