JESUS IS REVEALED THROUGH BAPTISM

The Baptism of the Lord marks the closing of the Christmas season and the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. As Jesus steps into the waters of the Jordan, He does so not because He needs repentance, but to stand in solidarity with humanity. In this moment, heaven opens, the Holy Spirit descends like a dove, and the voice of the Father proclaims, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." This powerful scene reveals who Jesus truly is: the Son of God, chosen and sent to bring salvation. God is made manifest not in grandeur or distance, but in humility and closeness, entering fully into our human story.

For us as Christians, this feast draws our attention to our own baptism. Through baptism, we are claimed by God, washed clean, and welcomed into a new identity as beloved sons and daughters.

In the Polish National Catholic Church, we cherish baptism as the foundation of our faith life and our call to live as witnesses in the world. Just as Jesus begins His mission after His baptism, we too are sent forth—to live the Gospel, to seek justice, and to serve others with love and compassion.

The Baptism of the Lord reminds us that faith is not meant to remain private or passive. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, we are called to reflect Christ in our daily lives—at home, in our parish, and in the wider community. When we remember our baptism, we are reminded that God delights in us and continues to call us to walk in faith, courage, and trust.

Reflection Questions:

1. How does remembering my own baptism shape the way I see myself as a beloved child of God?
2. In what ways is God calling me to live out my baptismal mission more fully in my daily life?
