DO I HONOR CHRIST IN MY WORK?

In Luke 10:38–42, we encounter the well-known story of Martha and Mary—two sisters who welcomed Jesus into their home. Mary sits at Jesus' feet, listening attentively, while Martha is preoccupied with the many tasks of hospitality. It's easy to assume that Jesus is criticizing Martha, but the truth is gentler and more compassionate. He never condemns her; rather, He tenderly invites her to see that her worry and distraction are keeping her from the one thing that truly matters—His presence.

Martha's actions stem from love and service, but they are clouded by anxiety and a longing for affirmation. Jesus does not scold her for working; He gently calls her name twice, signaling affection, and redirects her heart toward deeper peace. This passage reminds us that our busyness—even when directed toward good things—can distance us from the very relationship we're trying to honor. It's not a matter of choosing between service and stillness, but of aligning both with love and attentiveness to Christ.

We might ask ourselves: In all our doing—for family, church, or community—are we seeking to please Christ, or are we hoping to prove our worth? Our intentions matter deeply, and Jesus invites us not to abandon our work, but to root it in His love. When we sit at His feet first, our service becomes an overflow of grace rather than a burden of performance.


