ENCOUNTERING JESUS

In this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 20:27-38), Jesus is questioned by the Sadducees about the resurrection. They try to trap Him with a clever argument about marriage in the afterlife, but Jesus responds by lifting their vision beyond earthly limits. He reminds them—and us—that God “is not the God of the dead, but of the living, for to Him all are alive.” This truth calls us to live with hope, knowing that death is not the end but the doorway to eternal life with God.

As we journey through life, it's easy to get caught up in daily worries and forget that our true home is with God. The promise of resurrection invites us to live each day with faith, love, and purpose, trusting that everything we do for God and others has eternal meaning. The life we build here—through compassion, forgiveness, and service—reflects the life of the Kingdom to come.

Let us, as a community of faith at St. Jude's, renew our belief in the living God who holds us in love beyond death. May this assurance strengthen us to face life's challenges with courage and joy, confident that in Christ, we already share in the victory of resurrection.

1. How does my belief in the resurrection shape the way I live each day?
2. In what ways can I share God's promise of new life with others this week?
