ARE YOU PREPARED TO RECEIVE JESUS IN YOUR HEART?

Dear parishioners of St. Jude The Apostle. The Gospel delivers a potent, timeless call to genuine repentance as preparation for Jesus's coming. John the Baptist, a rugged prophet, demands more than just outward religious observance, famously confronting the hypocritical religious leaders as a "brood of vipers" who cannot rely on their lineage for salvation. The core message insists on producing "fruit in keeping with repentance," meaning a complete, life-altering change of heart and mind that leads to a TRANSFORMED lifestyle. This preparation is urgent because the Messiah is coming with the power to baptize in the Holy Spirit and fire, bringing both cleansing for the repentant "wheat" and unquenchable judgment for the unfruitful "chaff". Thus, the passage challenges us to move beyond mere regret for our sins and embrace a radical surrender to Christ, allowing his power to replace our self-sufficiency and bear visible fruit of love and obedience in our daily lives.

Are you prepared to receive Jesus in your heart?
