"WELCOMING EMMANUEL WITH TRUSTING HEARTS"

On this final Sunday of Advent, the Church invites us to contemplate the mystery of God-with-us. The Gospel places before us Saint Joseph, a man of integrity and deep faith, who is faced with a situation he cannot fully understand. In his uncertainty, Joseph chooses righteousness and mercy, seeking to act with compassion. When God speaks to him in a dream, Joseph listens and responds without hesitation, trusting that God is at work even beyond what he can see. Joseph's faithful response prepares the way for the birth of Christ and offers us a model for our own discipleship. As Christmas draws near, we are reminded that God often enters our lives quietly, asking for our cooperation and trust. Emmanuel comes not through power or force, but through humble obedience and loving openness. In this final stretch of Advent, we are called to make room for Christ in our hearts, our homes, and our daily choices, allowing God's plan to unfold through us.

Reflection Questions:

1. How do I respond when God's plans challenge my expectations or understanding?
2. In these final days of Advent, what can I do to more fully welcome Emmanuel—God-with-us—into my life?
