ENCOUNTERING JESUS

In this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 19:1-10), we meet Zacchaeus, a man of wealth and status who climbed a sycamore tree just to catch a glimpse of Jesus. His action might seem small, but it speaks to a deep spiritual hunger—an openness to encounter God even at the risk of looking foolish. When Jesus calls Zacchaeus down and declares He will stay at his house, we see the heart of divine mercy: God meets us where we are and invites us to transformation, not condemnation.

Zacchaeus' response is immediate and generous. He not only welcomes Jesus with joy but commits to restoring justice and making amends. This shows us that genuine encounter with Christ always leads to change—a conversion of heart that moves outward in love and generosity. It is a reminder that no one is beyond the reach of God's grace, and that mercy is not passive; it is active and life-giving.

As a community of faith at St. Jude the Apostle PNCC, we are called to seek that same encounter—to open our hearts, to climb our own "sycamore trees" of faith, and to welcome Christ into our homes and lives. In doing so, we renew our mission to live the Gospel through mercy, justice, and compassion.

Reflection Questions:

1. What "sycamore tree" might you need to climb to see Jesus more clearly in your life?
2. How can your encounter with God inspire a deeper generosity or reconciliation with others this week?

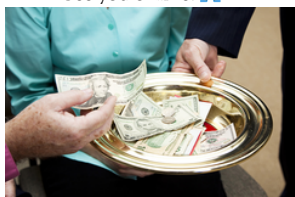
