

#### Chrsitian Prayer

Christian Prayer: The Litrugy of the Hours is a simplified, one-volume version of the Church's official daily prayer, designed for personal and communal use. Rooted in Scripture and tradition, the Litrugy of the Hours sanctifies the day by offering prayers as specific times: Morning Prayer (Lauds) at the start of the day, Daytime Prayer (Midmorning, Midday, or Midafferenoon), Evening Prayer (Sespens) at Gusk, and Night Prayer (Compline) before going to bed. The central prayer, the Office of Readings, may be prayed at any time and includes longer Scripture passages and reflections from the saints and Church tradition.



#### GOING OUT TWO BY TWO

In Luke 10:1–12, 17–20, Jesus sends out His followers two by two, telling them that the harvest is great but the laborers are few. This message speaks directly to us in the Polish National Catholic Church today. We are reminded that we are all called to be laborers in God's field—sharing His love, inviting others to church, and encouraging vocations to the priesthood. There is so much good work to be done in the world, and Jesus asks us to pray that more workers will answer the call. We especially invite our faithful to pray for young men to consider the priesthood, to serve the people of God and celebrate the sacraments that bring life to the Church.

As we go out into the world, whether through a kind word, a helping hand, or simply inviting someone to church, we share the presence of Jesus. The Polish National Catholic Church calls all of us to grow in our relationship with Christ and to help others do the same. Baptism begins this journey of faith, Holy Communion strengthens us with the real presence of Christ, and Scripture teaches us how to live as His disciples. When we live our faith with joy and honesty, others will see the difference Christ makes and will want to be a part of it too.

Now is the time to go out into the world and share what we have been given. The Church is not just a place to visit once a week—it is a family, a community, and a place where God's grace is poured out in love. If you feel a tug in your heart to serve, or if you know someone who might, don't be afraid to speak up. Come and see. Share the Word. Bring someone with you. In this way, we build up the Church, one soul at a time, just as Jesus sent His disciples to do long ago.


GREETINGS FROM OUR PASTOR: REV. DR. MARCUS R. TINAJERO
