

“BEHOLD THE LAMB OF GOD”

On this Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Gospel presents John the Baptist pointing to Jesus and proclaiming, “Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.” With these words, John shifts the focus away from himself and directs all attention to Christ. Jesus is revealed not only as a teacher or prophet, but as the sacrificial Lamb, sent by the Father for the salvation of all. This moment reminds us that our faith is not centered on ourselves or our achievements, but on recognizing who Jesus truly is and allowing Him to take His rightful place at the center of our lives.

In Ordinary Time, the Church invites us to live out the extraordinary grace we have received through Baptism. Like John, we are called to bear witness to Christ in the ordinary moments of daily life—through acts of kindness, honesty, patience, and love. As members of the Polish National Catholic Church, we are reminded that our calling is not only to believe in Christ privately, but to reflect His light publicly in our families, workplaces, and communities.

This Gospel also challenges us to listen attentively for God’s voice. John recognized Jesus because he was open to the Spirit’s guidance. In a world filled with noise and distraction, we too must cultivate hearts that are attentive to God’s presence. When we recognize Christ as the Lamb of God, we are invited to follow Him more faithfully, trusting that He takes away sin and leads us into new life.

Reflection Questions

1. In what ways is God calling me to point others to Christ through my words and actions?
2. How can I become more attentive to the presence of Jesus in the ordinary moments of my life?
