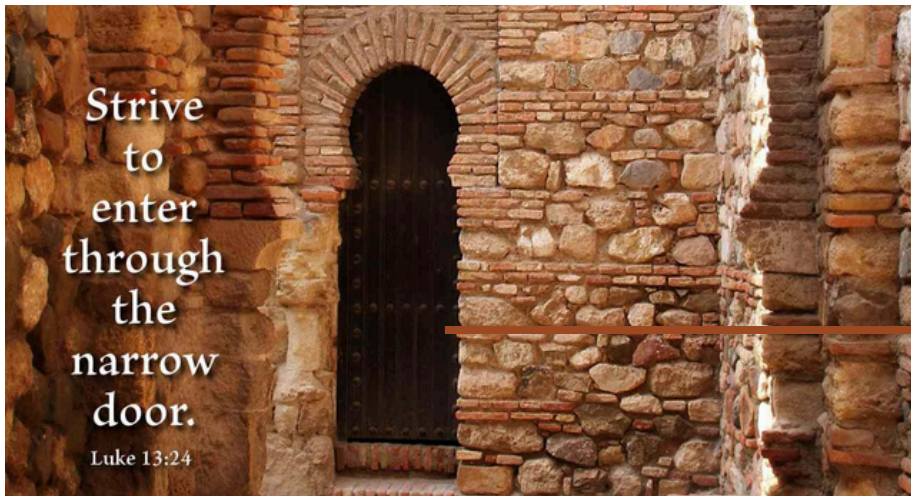

RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST, DO I ENTER?

In Luke 13:22-30, Jesus speaks about the narrow gate, reminding us that it is not enough to simply know about Him, but that we must truly have a relationship with Him. Many will say they ate and drank in His presence, but Jesus responds, "I do not know you." This is a hard truth—our salvation is not based on tradition, language, or culture alone, but on whether we have allowed Christ to enter our hearts and transform our lives. For us in the Polish National Catholic Church, with our rich traditions and deep love for our community, this Gospel challenges us not to rely only on outward signs of faith, but to ask if we are daily walking with Jesus in prayer, in service, and in love.

For all of us, family is central to our identity. We gather around tables, we honor our heritage, and we keep alive the faith of those who came before us. Yet, Jesus reminds us that even these blessings, as beautiful as they are, cannot replace our personal relationship with Him. He calls us to make room for Him not only in our churches and homes, but in our daily decisions, our struggles, and our celebrations. The narrow gate is not about exclusion, but about commitment—choosing Christ first, so that our families, our traditions, and our communities may be sanctified in His love. The invitation is personal: will Jesus know us by the love we live each day?
