Children of the Heavenly Father

Carolina Wilhelmina Sandell (Lina Sandell) was born on October 3, 1832, in the vicarage of Fröderyd, Småland, where her father served as the parish minister. She grew up with three sisters and one brother.

When Lina was 26, she took a trip with her father to Gothenburg. While en route, he fell overboard and drowned right before her eyes. She turned to her Savior and wrote many hymns during this time of grief. Songs such as "Children of the Heavenly Father" and "Day by Day" were born from her suffering, testifying to a faith that endures through the darkest of times Although she wrote over 650

hymns, only 14 were published. Oskar Ahnfelt composed or arranged the music for all of Lina's hymns. Lina remarked that Oskar "sang my songs into the hearts of the people."

In 1867, at the age of 35, Lina married Oscar Berg, a Stockholm merchant, but she continued to sign her hymns with the initials "L.S."

Jenny Lind, the "Swedish Nightingale," financed the first edition of Ahnfelt's Songs, which consisted mostly of Lina's hymns. This led to her hymns becoming popular in America and elsewhere.
