>>> SUNDAY SCHOOL




We know that summer is busy and a season of fun! We want to give parents and kids a space to grow in faith and community, and a holy break.



Lutheran World Relief School Bags

It's time to shop for school supplies! Please pick up an LWR school bag (or several bags) from the table at the back of the sanctuary. This is the list of supplies need to fill the bag. Return filled bags to the totes located by the South and North doors of the church. These bags will be shipped in October to Lutheran World Relief. This is a project of Fjeldberg WELCA, the Sewing Circle, and the Fjeldberg Youth. Last year we sent 244 School Bags. Let's try to surpass that total this year.

Supply List

Four (4) 70-sheet, wide-ruled spiral bound notebooks.
 Approximately 8" x 10.5". NO loose-leaf paper.



 One (1) blunt scissors (safety scissors with imbedded steel blades work well).

 One (1) 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimenters on one side and inches on the other.

- · One (1) pencil sharpener
- Five (5) <u>unsharpened</u> #2 pencils with erasers.
 Secure them together with a rubber band.
- One (1) eraser.
- Five (5) ballpoint pens (NO gel ink). Secure the together with a rubber band.
- One (1) box of 16 or 24 crayons..

DO NOT add other items or leave out any of the Items listed. Remove any excess packaging, pack the Items in the bag and return the bag to the church by Sunday, September 21
