ALL INVITED

INVESTED IN LOCAL AND GLOBAL MISSION - \$150,000

Every year, we support local and global mission partners. We have made a commitment that before we give money toward what we want to do, we make sure that we resource them do the incredible work they've been called by God to do. This year, we want to fully fund our local and global mission budget so that the work can continue in Oregon, and around the world.

INVESTED IN THE ASHLAND CAMPUS - \$425,000

In September, we will launch a second location in Ashland. This is a big undertaking that will take a lot of resources. Those resources will help us start and sustain new ministries, update the building, overhaul the sanctuary's audio/video/lighting system, and create engaging spaces for discipleship of our adults, kids, and students. We want to see that campus ready to reach thousands of people who need Jesus in the cities of Ashland and Talent!

INVESTED IN THE MEDFORD CAMPUS - \$215,000

Our building has been used to minister to people in the Valley for 50 years. That's worth celebrating! But it's also worth noting that there is some significant upkeep necessary to continue using that building for another 50 years. One of the items that needs to be replaced is the entire roof of the Worship Center and Ministry Center. We also want to invest in relaunching our Immigration Clinic. As we lay the groundwork with the government and with our Immigration partner organizations, we also need to hire staff and create spaces to meet with people and help them on their path to legal status. That ministry is so important, and we are committed to investing in it. Finally, we will invest in updating our Medford Sanctuary platform to make it more versatile so that we can have high-quality video elements for our video venues, online spaces, and our new Ashland Campus.

The cost of these objectives is higher than any one of us can handle alone, but it's not too high for us if we ALL invest together. **Our primary goal is to see 100% of our people participate at some level.** We want to see every New Lifer included in the mission by joining a group or a ministry team. We want to see every New Lifer invested in the vision through radical, faith-filled, sacrificial generosity. And we want to see everyone in the Valley invited to experience the hope that is found in Jesus alone.

We are the people of hope. Our best days are never behind us; they are in front of us. So let's stand firm on that promise, and go ALL IN together!
