

Story Spark Camp Summer Internship

Dates: 7 weeks, June 14- August 1, primarily Monday-Thursday, with some Friday/Sunday activities (approximately 40 hours/week)

Intern Pay: \$5000/ summer to be paid 2x month

Interns will:

- Work on a team of other young adults to lead the summer literacy programming for 1st-5th graders Monday-Thursday, beginning June 17
- Work alongside a team of volunteers to support the summer literacy program
- Have opportunities to apply personal skills and interests to support children at summer camp
- Participate in vocational discernment/spiritual practices throughout the summer
- Build leadership skills
- Lead lessons focused on literacy and SEL (social emotional learning)

- Willingness to become Safe Gatherings certified
- Organization/time management
- Basic knowledge/understanding of United Methodist theology (or willingness to learn)
- Creativity!
