Reflection and Application Questions:

1. Where have you recently encountered “bitter water” in your life—something that looked promising but left you disappointed, weary, or discouraged? How are you responding in that place: with complaint, silence, or prayerful dependence on God? What would it look like to bring that bitterness honestly before the Lord this week?
2. God provided a tree to heal the waters. What “tree” might God be offering you today—His Word, His presence, obedience, or a difficult act of faith—to transform bitterness into blessing? Is there a specific step of obedience or trust God is prompting you to take that could change how you experience your current trial?
3. God revealed Himself as “the Lord who heals,” and led Israel from a brief season of bitterness into a place of abundance. How does God’s promise of future glory (Romans 8:18; Revelation 21:4) reshape the way you view present suffering? What habits, attitudes, or faith practices can help you live today with confidence that your bitter season is temporary, but God’s provision and healing are enduring?
