Reflection Questions and Action Steps:

1. **What role has your upbringing or "godly home" (or lack thereof) played in shaping your faith, and how are you passing that legacy on—or beginning a new one—for others?** Action Step: *Reflect on Exodus 2:1–10 and Hebrews 11:23. Like Moses’ parents, are you choosing faith over fear in how you live and influence others? How can you exercise “sanctified common sense” in today’s cultural pressures?*
2. **How are you using your education, skills, and past experiences (even from a secular background) in service to God’s calling on your life?** Action Step: *Reflect on Acts 7:22. Are you dedicating all you’ve learned to God’s purpose? Are you open to letting Him use your strengths and even your failures for His glory?*
3. **What has God been doing in your “wilderness seasons” – the times of delay, confusion, or rejection – to prepare you for what’s next?** Action Step: *Reflect on Exodus 2:15–25 and the 40 years Moses spent in Midian. Are you resisting or embracing the preparation? How might God be using your current season to humble and shape you, just as He did with Moses?*
