Set Free: How God Delivers, Develops, & Deploys His People, Sermon #5 Sermon Text: Exodus 4:1-17

•	With God's Power, the Ordinary becomes the (Verses 1-5, 17, 20)
	With God's Power, Obedience activates (vs. 15-16)
	With God's Power there is a Danger of (Numbers 20:7-11)

Reflection and Application Questions:

- 1. What is currently "in your hand" that God might want to use for His purpose? Reflection: Moses only had a staff, but God used it to perform miracles. Application: Consider the skills, resources, or opportunities you already have. Have you surrendered them to God for His use, or are you underestimating their potential?
- 2. Where might God be asking you to take a step of obedience—even if it seems risky or small?
 - **Reflection:** Miracles in Moses' story didn't begin until he obeyed God's instructions. **Application:** Is there an area in your life where you're waiting for God to move, but He's actually waiting for you to act in faith?
- 3. Are you relying on past experiences with God, or are you actively listening for fresh instructions today?

Reflection: Moses disobeyed when he struck the rock instead of speaking to it—because he relied on what worked before.
