Worship Intern

The goal of this internship is to equip and develop well-rounded worship leaders who are spiritually grounded, musically skilled, and capable of leading teams with excellence and humility.

Position Summary

The Worship Intern will assist in leading and supporting the worship ministry while actively developing skills in musical leadership, production, and team dynamics. This role is designed to provide hands-on experience in both platform leadership and behind-the-scenes preparation, with intentional mentorship and spiritual growth.

Primary Responsibilities

- Lead and assist with worship during College Nights, Rally Nights, and Sunday morning services
- Prepare and maintain snacks and drinks for the worship team in the green room
- Help oversee worship team scheduling in collaboration with Chase and Sierra
- Assist in planning and preparation for Team Nights
- Participate in rehearsals, sound checks, and service execution
- Support general worship ministry needs during gatherings and office hours

Development Focus

This internship is centered on growth as a worship leader. Interns will receive training and coaching in:

- Vocal development (singing)
- Instrument proficiency
- Speaking and stage communication
- Leading rehearsals effectively
- Building tracks using Ableton Live
- Audio fundamentals and live sound
- Worship production and technical elements
- Leadership development and team dynamics

Spiritual & Leadership Growth

- Interns will read Worship Matters throughout both the Fall and Spring semesters.
- Weekly meetings with Worship Pastor will be held to discuss assigned reading and apply principles to real ministry contexts
- Emphasis will be placed on developing both spiritual depth and practical leadership insight

Schedule & Commitment

- Majority of hours will take place during:
- Worship gatherings (services, events, rehearsals)
- Scheduled office hours
- Weekly meeting for mentorship and book discussion
- Additional time may be required for preparation and special events

Hours Required: 15 hours/week at \$12/hour (40 Weeks in total: 20 in the Fall & 20 in the Spring)
