We Receive...	Scripture	Key Thought
Salvation	Ephesians 2:8; John 1:12	Salvation is received by grace through faith, not achieved by works.
Forgiveness	Acts 10:43; Colossians 1:13–14	Through Christ we receive forgiveness of sins.
Grace	John 1:16; Hebrews 4:16	“From His fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.”
Mercy	Hebrews 4:16	We come boldly to God’s throne to “receive mercy.”
Righteousness	Romans 5:17	Those who “receive the abundance of grace and the free gift of righteousness...”
Adoption	Romans 8:15; Galatians 4:4–7	We receive the Spirit of adoption and become sons and daughters.
The Holy Spirit	Acts 2:38; Galatians 3:14	Through faith we “receive the promised Spirit.”
Power	Acts 1:8	“You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you.”
Love	Romans 5:5; 1 John 4:19	God’s love is “poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit.”
Joy	John 15:11; Romans 15:13	Jesus gives us His joy, and God fills us with joy as we trust Him.
Peace	John 14:27; Philippians 4:6–7	“My peace I give to you.”
Hope	Romans 15:13; 1 Peter 1:3	God causes us to abound in hope through the Holy Spirit.
Strength	Isaiah 40:29–31; Ephesians 3:16	God strengthens His people with power through His Spirit.
Wisdom	James 1:5; Proverbs 2:6	If anyone lacks wisdom, “let him ask God, who gives generously.”
Understanding	2 Timothy 2:7; Proverbs 2:6	“The Lord will give you understanding in everything.”
Knowledge of God	Ephesians 1:17; Colossians 1:9–10	God gives spiritual wisdom and revelation so that we may know Him.

Guidance	Psalms 32:8; Proverbs 3:5–6	“I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go.”
Truth	John 16:13; John 8:31–32	The Spirit guides believers into truth.
Rest	Matthew 11:28–29	“Come to Me...and I will give you rest.”
Comfort	2 Corinthians 1:3–4	God is “the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our affliction.”
Encouragement	Romans 15:5; 2 Thessalonians 2:16–17	God gives encouragement and strengthens our hearts.
Freedom	John 8:36; 2 Corinthians 3:17	“If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.”
Victory	1 Corinthians 15:57; Romans 8:37	“Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”
Provision	Philippians 4:19; Matthew 6:31–33	“My God will supply every need of yours.”
Protection	Psalms 91:1–4; 2 Thessalonians 3:3	God is faithful to strengthen and guard His people.
Deliverance	Psalms 34:4,17; Colossians 1:13	God delivers His people from fear, trouble, and the domain of darkness.
A New Heart	Ezekiel 36:26–27	“I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you.”
A New Identity	2 Corinthians 5:17; Colossians 3:3–4	In Christ we become a new creation.
Freedom From Condemnation	Romans 8:1	“There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.”
Access to God	Ephesians 2:18; Hebrews 10:19–22	Through Christ we have confident access to the Father.
Fellowship With God	1 Corinthians 1:9; 1 John 1:3	We are called into fellowship with the Father and His Son.
Contentment	Philippians 4:11–13; 1 Timothy 6:6	Christ supplies strength that enables contentment in every circumstance.
Boldness	2 Timothy 1:7; Acts 4:29–31	God gives His people power rather than a spirit of fear.
Endurance	Colossians 1:11; Romans 15:5	God strengthens believers for endurance and patience.
