#### FOR ALL OF US HERE AT FIRST, 2023 WAS A MONUMENTAL YEAR!

- ① 22 NEW MEMBERS JOINED OUR CHURCH FAMILY IN 2023.
  - How blessed we are by so many new members. They have brought a lot of vibrancy, enthusiasm, and faithfulness with them, and if you haven't had a chance to get to know them yet, you've short-changed yourself. [BTW, you have a chance to meet some of them with our church-wide meals that are planned for this next year. See this newsletter for more information.]
- ② WE SEPARATED FROM OUR UNITED METHODIST ROOTS AND BECAME A GLOBAL METHODIST CHURCH CONGREGATION.

This involved a mountain of work, continual prayers\_and shouldering a hefty financial obligation, all in the name of being faithful to the Lord and his Scriptures. Many, many of our leaders helped steer us through this convoluted and sometimes confounding process.

- > We had to legally change our name and logo and all the accompanying signage.
- ➤ We had to pay a \$196,202 "disaffiliation fee." In a remarkable answer to this requirement, our congregation (you!!) have not only kept up with our regular operating budget but also raised \$204,676 to meet this need and begin paying ourselves back for the additional costs we incurred in this process. WOW!!
- 3 2023 ALSO SAW SIGNIFICANT STAFF CHANGES FOR OUR CHURCH.

We <u>released Pastor Charmaigne</u> from her ministry here to help meet the needs of this new GMC denomination. She is now pastoring at Bethel Global Methodist Church in Oak Ridge, NC and is making significant differences in her new congregation. Late this fall, to help with our ministry needs, <u>we</u> <u>welcomed Beth Woods</u> onto the ministry team as our COORDINATOR OF LAY MINISTRIES. She is helping us move forward in some terrific new ways and will help us take next steps into the future God has for us.

Someone once said: "Forget the past, it's gone, but glance back occasionally to remind yourself where you came from and where you are going." This is the "glance back." Next week, I want to think about where we're going, because that's where the Lord is leading us....into a great future! Happy New Year!


