Going Global with the Gospel--Kenya Mission Trip

We're excited to share that a team from our church family will travel to Nairobi and Kisii, Kenya, September 19- 29, 2025. We will share the love and truth of Jesus Christ with widows, orphans, and others through evangelism and service, hosting a Vacation Bible School, distributing food, and assisting in a medical clinic.

How You Can Be a Part of This Global Mission

We believe missions are not just about those who go — the entire church family can make a global impact for the Kingdom. Here are three meaningful ways you can support us:

1. PRAY

Prayer is the most powerful support you can offer. Please join us in praying:

- For God's wisdom to lead and guide us as we travel and minister throughout Kenya.
- For protection—as we step into spiritually dark places, may His light shine through us.
- For provision—spiritual and physical needs- for the team and those we serve.

2. GIVE SUPPLIES

We are collecting the following items to bless those we'll minister to:

- Materials for salvation bracelets We'll have a church-wide bracelet-making event soon!

Vacation Bible School 2025 Meeting & Workday

Oh, magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt His name together!

WORKDAY: We will meet at **10:00 on Thursday, May 29** to work on materials and decorations for Vacation Bible School. It's going to be BIG! All hands are welcome for this workday.

Almond Oatmeal Lace Cookies (From Beth Woods)

- 1 Tablespoon plain flour
- 1/4 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 cup of old-fashioned (not instant) oatmeal
- 1 cup thinly sliced almonds (about 3-4 oz)

Combine above ingredients and set aside.

1 stick of melted butter

% cup of sugar

Mix together and set aside.

- 1 egg (beaten)
- 1 teaspoon of vanilla extract

Mix wel

Pour wet ingredients into dry ingredients. Stir all together by hand until the dough is wet. (It will look runny.) Drop small spoonful's onto parchment paper lined cookie sheet. Gently spread the dough out using a circular motion. Be careful... an uncooked 2-inch spot of dough will spread to 4-6 inches! So, use small amounts and don't place close together.

Bake at 325 degrees for 12-15 minutes. Watch them and remove when the edges are golden and the centers are semi-translucent. Let cool on the pan. Makes approximately 2 dozen.

*You can add chia/flax/hemp seed mix and coconut for variety and a bit of nutrition. You can substitute gluten-free flour with no problems. And you can substitute up to half of the butter with coconut oil to make it a bit healthier.

This recipe originally came from Gayle Price, a wonderfully sweet lady from Tabernacle Methodist Church in Greensboro. She brought them to almost every covered dish meal and she shared the recipe freely!
