HURRICANE KELENE RELIEF

The images are horrific and the loss is catastrophic. Of North Carolina's 44 westernmost counties, **22 were directly impacted by Hurricane Helene.** As we continue to hear about the immense devastation caused by Hurricane Helene, I am overwhelmed not only by the damage and deaths, but also by the caring response of so many people — especially faithful Global Methodists across North Carolina. Paul Dunham (our NC GMC Disaster Response Coordinator), along with our conference, have been working hard to check in with affected community leaders, clergy, and disaster response teams.

The NC GMC organized swiftly after Helene devastated the western part of NC. **Many churches are serving as collection hubs for donated supplies**. From there, the supplies are being distributed to local communities, neighboring churches, local fire departments, and other partnering organizations.

Please prayerfully consider the list of ways you can help. I know that our Global Methodist family will continue to show up in abundance to help those whose lives and livelihoods have been impacted by this storm. Thank you for your generosity and support.

- > Food or gas gift cards
- > Paper products (plates, napkins, cups)
- ➢ Socks
- Non-perishable food
- Ensure supplemental drinks
- > Manual can openers
- Diapers (adult and baby)
- Baby formula
