

BACK PACK PROGRAM (CORNER TABLE)

The Corner Table is asking for volunteers on the 1st Wednesday of each month from 10am-11am beginning in September until June to help pack grocery bags with 7 to 8 items so school children otherwise would not have something to eat on the weekends. The address is 1925 Tate Blvd, Hickory, NC 28602.

The packed bags will be for school children who will have something to eat when not in school. There are **1600 bags** (not 160 as listed in the Newsletter last week) distributed weekly to all the schools in Catawba County.

It is not hard work, just walking in a long loop, placing canned or boxed food items in a plastic grocery bag, tying a knot in the bag and placing the bag in a large bin.

We would like to get at least 10 volunteers who could help with this ministry once a month to help feed these kids who may go hungry otherwise.
