Oops! I forgot my nametag! (Is that familiar??)

It's easy to do! And I promise, a nametag is not a requirement for entry to our sanctuary! But I would like to share a few of the reasons why we like nametags and the benefits they provide.

- 1. Most of us don't know everybody's names! As our church continues to grow, this truth becomes even more relevant. We want to be a fellowship of friends, and the first step to that is learning names. Nametags help with that.
- 2. Nametags invite conversations. Knowing another person's name breaks down one barrier to allow conversations to begin. It's simply easier to talk to someone if you know their name. We encourage you to take conversations deeper when you can, but every friendship has to have a first conversation!
- 3. Nametags save embarrassment. We've probably all called someone by the wrong name, only to realize it later. While calling each other "brother" or "sister" sounds good (and is theologically on target), it's often a cover-up for "I'm sorry I don't know your name, and I'm embarrassed to ask." That's uncomfortable for both parties.
- **4. Name tags foster a welcoming environment.** Simply knowing someone's name creates an instant connection. When you don't have to ask their name and you can introduce yourself without pressure, you will feel more confident and make more acquaintances. After all, a stranger is just a friend you haven't met yet.

So, now that we see the benefits, how can we help make this ministry more effective?

- 1. If you can, find a convenient place to keep your nametag. Some people keep it in their car. I keep mine in my purse. Do whatever works for you.
- 2. Don't fret if you forget. We believe in grace here! We will have a supply of blank nametags on hand in the narthex. Just make a new one.
- 3. Let Robin (in the church office) know if you don't have a nametag or have lost yours! Even if you haven't yet joined, you can have a nametag made. We want to know your name!
- 4. Nametags will be available to visitors too! This is an especially important step in helping all of us welcome visitors and make them feel comfortable.

Along the same lines, I'm still working on updating our church directory, so please let me know if your information is incorrect, incomplete, or totally missing!
