7 Ways to Pray Through Election Year Fears

But keeping a level head and a prayerful heart is the best way to make the right choices for candidates, issues, and the future of our country.

Here are seven tips to direct your prayers and help you be aware of what is most significant this year. After all, politicians will come and go, but God remains with us for eternity.

1. Pray to Keep Your Head and Heart at Peace and Aware

It can be very easy to let this election get the best of us emotionally. This can lead to arguments, strained relationships, and even extreme actions. 
