The Three Trees

The Family Tree is decorated with ornaments given by many members of First Methodist Church. Some ornaments bear the family names and a special date; others are anonymous. Together, they create a patchwork of connection through the years and across the miles.

Third, our tree of symbolism: The Chrismon Tree

It is set up near the organ in the Sanctuary.

The Chrismon Tree is decorated with ornaments made by members of First Methodist Church many years ago. The word "Chrismon" comes from "Christ" and "monogram" and it refers to symbols that represent Christ. These range from crosses to crowns to stars to lambs. Each symbol has a particular meaning and each one helps tell the story of Christ at Christmas. Take a moment each Sunday of Advent to study these beautiful ornaments!
