Our NEW church directory is a great resource tool that will allow you to get to know our church family better.

We're asking everyone to try to log in this week and check your own family's entries. If you find errors or incomplete information, you can choose the "Edit my Household" option. From here, you can request changes such as:

- Family photo
- Name spelling
- Email addresses
- Phone numbers
- Update family members
- Birthdays and anniversaries

There are several options for accessing the directory: online on a computer or other device, through an app on a mobile device such as a phone or tablet, or a printed version (will be available after final proofs are completed). You also have the option to print it at home through the online version.

To view the directory online, go to [members.InstantChurchDirectory.com](https://members.InstantChurchDirectory.com) and follow the prompts under "Sign In" to "Create a login now." Please remember, you must confirm your email address before you can sign in.

There is also a free mobile app available for download at the Apple® App store in iTunes®, Google Play™ store and the Amazon Fire App Store. Simply search for "**Instant Church Directory**" to get the download.

You will need to use your email address as listed in our directory to create a log-in the first time you use the directory online and via the mobile app.

By the way, this company has security measures in place and they cannot access your private information. Only those who are listed in the directory can see your information, but you can also choose to make your information private through the edit function. Michael Moritz was a great man. He served his community in many ways. He was a volunteer firefighter in Conover for 21 years, he volunteered at our church youth basketball program as a coach for 10 years and served as an assistant boy scout master for 15 years. He and I were married for 27 years, and we have 2 children.



On December 24, 2022, Michael entered his Heavenly home. He passed away with Myelofibrosis, a rare form of blood cancer. Michael received 19 units of blood and 3 bags of platelets. It is because of donors like you that we were able to have a few extra months with Michael. He is dearly missed every day.

Blood donations are a way that we can honor Michael's life and to keep his memory alive.

On December 21, 2024, Crystal was diagnosed with a rare form of leukemia called Mixed Phenotype Acute Leukemia, and Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia, a blood cancer of the bone marrow. She has since received countless blood transfusions (up to 12+ pints), and up to 20 units of platelets. I don't know what we would have done without the help



of people who donated blood and platelets. She has undergone several rounds of chemo and will need another full round in the coming months before the bone marrow transplant. During this process, she will receive high doses of chemotherapy and will spend at least 30 days in the hospital and several months of recovery.

### ASHURE MINISTRY'S 7TH ANNUAL MARCH MADNESS CHALLENGE

Good morning, and welcome to our 7th Annual March Madness Challenge! Last year we collected over 42,000 pounds of food and over \$12,000, making a significant impact on hunger in our area. Our March Madness Challenge rallies businesses, churches, schools, and individuals to compete in donating food or funds under their favorite NCAA basketball team's banner, all while supporting a great cause!

The challenge works like this: from March 1st through April 9th we ask people to donate food or money on behalf of their favorite college basketball team. Food is always a slam dunk for us, so it will count as 1 pound = 2 points. Financial donations help us score even more, so money counts as \$1 = 3 points. The team with the most points at the end of the period wins the challenge! We will be announcing the individual, church, and business with the greatest contributions.

## Preparation for "Journey to Jerusalem" Prayer Walk April 13-18, 2025

The "Journey to Jerusalem" Prayer Walk is coming soon! This immersive walk-through experience tells the life and ministry of Jesus Christ, from Creation and the fall, prophecies to birth, through His ministry, and to His death and resurrection. It draws nearly 1000 visitors from our community each year. For the week of April 13-18, the Connor Family Life Center will be totally transformed into winding passageways that tell this moving story with scenes, sounds, scents, costumed characters, and live action. It is an enormous undertaking

that requires many hours of work from many people. And we can use YOUR help! We need people willing to set up room dividers, hang fabric, set up scenes, and act as costumed hosts.

### Work days:

- ASSEMBLY workday – Thursday, March 13. We can use many hands to assemble give-away items for both the Prayer Walk and the Easter 4 Children events. This will be mostly sitting down and low stress, with a good opportunity for fellowship too!
- On March 22, beginning at 9:00 am, a crew will begin to clear out rooms and move the crates and supplies from the storage building into the CFLC. All hands are welcome!
- On March 23, beginning at 2:00 pm, a crew will finish clearing out rooms and begin to assemble the displays. All hands are welcome!
- Week of March 23- March 29, the three classrooms in the CFLC will be set up. To volunteer to help with these, contact Beth Woods (336) 480-4551, Jimmy Clark, (828) 217-5102, Bev Swithenbank (828) 320 5542, Jeanette Stewart (828) 315-0821, Anita Deal (828) 320-3194, Cindy Clark (828) 302-3217, or Tamara Hite (828) 514-5604.
- On March 30 at 2:00, a crew will be assembling the divider walls and hanging fabric on them to create pathways through the CFLC. Work on this will continue through this week.
- There will also be work going on throughout April 1-12, watch for more details on this in future newsletters.
- On April 13, right after the late service, a crew will be setting up the last of the hallway scenery.
- Each night of the Prayer Walk (April 13, 14, 15, 16, and 18 – not open on Maunday Thursday) we need about 25 costumed volunteers to sit quietly as part of the "scenery" and to provide assistance to visitors in the case of an emergency. - On April 19, beginning at 9:00, we will disassemble and pack away the entire set-up. This is an enormous task, and we need anybody who is willing to come donate even an hour or two.
