


The Weekly Newsletter of First Methodist Church Conover

Six months ago this week (September 27, 2024), Hurricane Helene hit the US with gale force winds, spawning tornadoes, flooding, mudslides, power outages, and unspeakable devastation. Helene was one of the costliest weather disasters in history, causing an estimated \$78.7 BILLION in damages. The official death toll is 249 deaths, with several people still unaccounted for.

Untold thousands of hours of rescue efforts have been poured out for those devastated by this hurricane. Only God knows the amount of donations in cash, material goods, food, and equipment that has been given to help. Rebuilding is happening. Comfort has been given in so many loving ways. And I know this church has been part of that effort.

So, why am I writing about this now? Last Friday, I had the opportunity to visit with a family friend who lives in Black Mountain. She took me into Swannanoa to see a coffee shop that is trying to rebuild so they can serve their community. I experienced the well-known phenomena that "pictures don't do it justice." Friends, the devastation is still there.

Yes, the rebuilding is happening. People are still giving. But I don't want us to forget that the need is also still real.

I'm issuing a challenge to YOU... our church family at First Methodist Church of Conover to pray, think, and find ways to continue to reach out to those in need. Specifically, I challenge you to look up a church or organization in one of the affected areas. Call them and ask what they need. How can we help? Maybe it's money; maybe it's sending supplies (but let's find out what they need and not just send what we think they need!); maybe it's sponsoring a fun day for the children; maybe it's food... I don't know. If you have the means to drive to an area that is hurting, go eat in a restaurant or shop in a bookstore. Support their local economy.

As this 6-month mark comes this week, let's try to find a way to be a neighbor – a Good Samaritan -- to the mountains of North Carolina.
