PRESCRIPTION FOR THE WEARY

When Walt Disney animated the story of Snow White, he created seven memorable, even if short characters - the seven dwarfs. I'm not one of them! Now, I'm not going to ask you to name them; we'll save that for a game of Trivial Pursuit or something. But I always loved that little song they sang on the way to work.

And they didn't exactly work in an environmentally-controlled office building. They worked in a mine all day. Not the greatest place to work! But each day they would merrily march off to work singing, (I bet you know it....here we go.) "Hi-ho, Hi-ho, it's off to work we go." Wow! What a great way to approach your responsibilities. Anyone who does that has a giant heart, not one that's "dwarfed."



Some time back, I attended a meeting and one woman expressed a feeling that, as it turned out, everybody in the room agreed with. She said, "You know, people are working around here, and they get very discouraged, or they quit because of one word — weariness." And I watched a lot of heads nodding in that room.

Turns out, there are a lot of folks who struggle with a deep weariness, and it's far beyond physical. They're just tired of pushing, or of being one of the few who seem to care. They're tired of little results for a lot of work, and maybe not being appreciated. It can even happen in our Christian walk.

Which leads me to this Word from God. Hebrews 12:2-4 says "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider Him who endured such opposition from sinful men..." Then it continues, "...so that you will not grow weary and lose heart."

Weariness, according to Hebrews 12, seems to result from taking your eyes off Jesus. Maybe you're weary because you've been doing life in your strength. You know better, but you've gone from God working through you to the crank-it-out weariness of you suddenly working for God. Oh, you're doing the same things, but it's not Him through you. Or it could be that you've been looking at the results you're getting instead of the Savior you're serving. He gives the results, He gives the rewards - people don't.

Is it time to get your eyes back toward the Jesus whose love compelled you to serve in the first place? I like how that praise song encourages us to "Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus."

This week, take the time to really concentrate and focus on the Lord — on His provision for your life, on His ongoing, unending grace, on His Spirit who undergirds your day and will pour into you all you need.


