Forgiveness

I'm thinking about forgiveness at the moment. It's an extraordinary and amazing gift. It's also one that I've personally needed to receive myself this week. Maybe you too. Have you been hurt? Done wrong? Been bruised up emotionally? Made fun of, or bullied? We all have at one time or another. More than that, there've been times we were on the "doling out" end of some of that same activity that hurt us. We've hurt others. How do you handle that when it happens? If you're like most people, the idea of forgiveness is something we all want offered to us, but may struggle to give to others.

The Bible teaches that God made us, designed us, and that He loves us, which means He knows what is best for us. Forgiveness is one of the divine plans God has for each of us. Over and over in the Bible, we are told two unchanging truths about forgiveness.

First, we need to be forgiven. It's the reason, the rationale, the cause for Christ's death on the cross. All of us have messed up, fallen short, caused hurt — to God, and to others. This point is driven home over and over in the scriptures.

And when we recognize that we've failed...or offended, or hurt, or botched things up, our only recourse to repair the relational damage we're inflicted, is to acknowledge what we've done and ask the Lord to forgive us. And the amazing news the Bible proclaims is that when we do ask, God is "faithful and just, and will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all [our] unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9). I love what the Bible says in Psalm 103: "As far as the east is from the west, so far has He

removed our transgressions from us" (Psalm 103:12).

Second, the God who made us and knows what's best for us commands us to do the same thing: to forgive. Forgiveness is the supernatural lubrication that makes our lives together become more like Christ. God tells us to "be kind, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, just as in Christ, God forgave you." (Eph. 4:32). The Bible is quite clear to us just how important this is. The Lord wants us to understand that our own forgiveness from God is inextricably tied to

our willingness to forgive others. This is what Jesus (Jesus!) says: "For if you forgive others...your Heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions" (Matt 6:14-15).

Clearly, the practice of forgiveness is God's best for us in the here-and-now and it's also His best for us for all eternity. Of course, it's not always easy, which is why Jesus offers to help us through His Holy Spirit, who is at work in us. But developing a forgiving heart can lift your heart, give you peace of mind and make you more like your Savior. Now that's good news!
