Out of the Woods — "The Friend Who Stands Beside"

Jackie Robinson was the first black person to play major league baseball. While breaking baseball's "color barrier," he faced many crowds who jeered him in every stadium he came to. While playing one day at his home stadium in Brooklyn, he committed an error. His own fans began to ridicule him. He stood at second base, humiliated, while thousands of fans heckled, hissed and booed.

Suddenly, shortstop "Pee Wee" Reese came over and stood next to him. Pee Wee put his arm around Jackie Robinson and together they faced the crowd. Quickly, the fans grew silent. Robinson later said that arm around his shoulder saved his career.

We've all been there, I suppose...standing in need of someone to face our problems with us. I can think of several people who have been there for me in a time of difficulty, standing at my side, showing solidarity and love. I'd also like to believe that there have been times we were there for that person who needed the encouraging arm around their shoulder.

In Galatians, the apostle Paul writes these words: "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ" (Gal. 6:2). That's a good word for us, because it means that this gospel will be incomplete unless we partner together to fulfill it. Open yourself today to find someone whose burdens you might lighten. It just might make an eternal difference!

Dear Church Family,

I hope this message finds you well. I am writing to seek your support for some financial donations towards a meaningful Venturing Summit project that I'm very passionate about. Venturing is a branch of Scouting America for young men and women, ages 14 - 21, and is focused on self development. Venturing groups are more active in high adventure activities. The Venturing Summit project is the equivalent of the Eagle Scout project where the Summit candidate must complete a service project for a school or religious facility that means something to them and the project must be something that will affect the community positively. My project will be to install shelving in the Newton-Conover High School band trailer to give a safe space for the smaller band instruments to be stored. 
